Welcome to the construction site 😊

So cool that you're here!

A little safety information when attending a construction site.

Before you begin, we want to remind you of some things you might take for granted...

1. Personal protective equipment

The construction site requires a helmet, safety shoes and visibility clothing. Personnel encountered without this will receive a verbal warning, then a written warning and finally expulsion from the construction site. The same will apply in the absence of safety / welding goggles when needed.

The contractors' employees bring the necessary personal protective equipment (helmet, safety shoes, goggles, visibility vest / jacket), and also necessary dust masks, gloves and etc.

2. Notification of accidents / first aid equipment

A list of emergency telephones and who is to be notified is posted on all information boards. There are also first aid kits hanging on these strategically placed boards.

Use of ladders

Accidental use of ladders is the leading cause of fall accidents. They must be secured against slipping and only used for temporary access. (DO NOT work in ladder) The length of ladder must be according to The regulations. The end must be mine. 1m over edge.

4. Drawing and writing on walls

Writing and drawings on walls in the building and on the WC will not be accepted. BH will continuously paint over drawings / texts and other «works of art»

The costs of this will be notified and distributed to the contractors who are on the construction site

5. Scaffolding / railings / recesses

Modifying / moving parts of a scaffolding can endanger the lives of others. The same applies if you remove the railing / cover of recesses without putting this back after you. Failure to comply with this entails a warning orally, in writing and finally expulsion from the construction site

6. Chemicals / substances

Make sure you have the necessary equipment and protective equipment present when handling chemicals / substances

Substance files must be available on the construction site (digital is preferable)

7. Winter work

During winter work, you must pay special attention to slippery and difficult access, barracks area, container area, stilts and building site. Good lighting conditions where needed are important for safe access. Contribute to common security for all

8. Cleaning and tidiness on the construction site as well as walkways

In all walkways outside the site, inside the building, on scaffolding or lifts / lifts, there shall be NO storage of materials and equipment, this also applies to all forms of temporary storage or disposal of goods / equipment.

Every contractor cleans according to their own work. In particular, make sure that materials and cuttings are disposed of in the RIGHT container. There are requirements for waste sorting at this construction site

9. Barrack / grandstand building

Contribute to your well-being on the "pocket and eat" with self-cleaning. Take into account the cleaning and use of the shoe-free zone

10. Info

You / we should never walk past something that could potentially harm someone. Pits / holes in the area protection for the building site will be repaired if possible, if the construction management is not notified.
